

SQUASH COACH

From September 2014 Old Swinford Hospital seeks to appoint a Squash Coach, who must offer a suitable degree of competence in coaching squash to contribute to the work of the Sports Department.

THE SCHOOL

Old Swinford Hospital is one of the country's leading state boarding schools. Sixty per cent of the School's 660 students are boarders who come from a wide range of backgrounds in the UK, EU and overseas and the School is oversubscribed at every admission stage.

The School enjoys a very good academic reputation and regularly features in the lists of the most academically successful maintained schools. A highly positive OfSTED inspection took place during Lent term 2013. The school prides itself on a balance of fine academic achievement and providing outstanding opportunities to develop leadership through an extensive extra-curricular programme within which sport, music, CCF, outdoor pursuits, Duke of Edinburgh and drama feature strongly.

By tradition, Old Swinford Hospital is a school for boys. However, girls joined the School as Sixth Form day students for the first time in 2004 and there are now some 80 girls amongst the Sixth Form of 280.

Old Swinford Hospital was granted as a highly popular and successful school £10 million by the Government in 2006 in order to expand by a further one hundred and fifty pupils over the following five years. One hundred of these additional places were for boarders. A major building programme was completed which includes a large extension to an already impressive sports centre, an all-weather floodlit sports pitch, a new teaching block with a specialist arts room, a performing arts centre and a new senior boarding house. Other recent developments include a new off-site sports ground, a new food technology centre and a complete refurbishment and extension to the Year 7 Boarding House.

SPORTS DEPARTMENT AT OLD SWINFORD HOSPITAL

The Physical Education Department at Old Swinford Hospital has 6 qualified PE teachers who teach a broad and balanced curriculum at both KS 3 and 4. The department also offers its students the opportunity to pursue their interest in the subject to GCSE and A level standard.

Extra curricular sports clubs play a huge part in the life of this busy boarding school and participation rates at both a house and school level are very high. The school employs a number of specialist coaches to assist with running school teams and coaching at all levels.

- Excellent interpersonal skills to help deliver high quality sport or activities and an ability to work with a range of age groups;
- Good planning and organisational skills;

- Conscientious, reliable and enthusiastic;

JOB SPECIFICATION

The Squash Coach is responsible to the Director of Sport and PE for the provision of coaching squash two evenings per week.

Any other duties that can be reasonably be expected as requested by the Headmaster and the Director of Sports and PE.

The Squash Coach is required two evening per week to work on Monday and one other evening from 7.30pm to 10.00pm during term time only (36 weeks).
